Canadian Raptor Conservancy

Birds In Flight Photography Session allows the photographer a unique opportunity to get close up and personal with a variety of birds of prey. Each session is three hours in length and includes flying birds such as the snowy owl and golden eagle and others as time allows. This is a great chance for amazing photos and the chance to learn about the natural history of each species. This venue is an indoor and outdoor facility. Birds of prey will not fly if winds are above 60km/hr.

The maximum number of photographers allowed is 12. Initially, this event will be open only to paid members of The St Catharines Photographic Club until December 12, 2017. The first twelve people to submit the fee of \$50 + HST (56.50) cash to Bob Jones or Lawrence Robson will go. After Dec.12 if space is available the event will be open to other clubs and friends. Non members of The St Catharines Photographic Club may be required to sign a waiver to be accepted.

As usual, those who wish to pool or offer a ride will meet at Tim Hortons on Geneva Street and the QEW in St Catharines and be prepared to leave by 10:30am. Our session starts at 1:00pm. Travel time to the location of the Raptor Conservancy is about one hour and forty minutes but weather, road and traffic conditions may dictate a longer travel time.
